Dear all
I take this opportunity to inform you that the Regional, Zonal and District programmes till date were very effective and commendable. We could achieve the desired membership during the second semester and also we could collect the hundred percent dues.
February is the month for promoting International Projects. Our existence in and around our society is shown by various noble service projects done by each club every year locally. But our International organization promotes and co-ordinates many programmes intended to provide service and assistance to problems that are beyond the capability of an individual club. Also globally our presence is felt by these various International projects. It also promotes the International aspect of our movement. Few International Projects are Time of fast, Endowment Fund and Roll Back Malaria.
In Time Of Fast [TOF] programme each member is asked to skip one meal, Rs 100/- and send this amount to International Head Quarters. By this each member will get some idea of what it means to suffer from being hungry, reminding them about the millions of people for whom this is a daily reality. The money is used to alleviate various human crisis throughout the world like refugee rehabilitation, schools, nurseries, old age homes for the under privileged etc.
Regarding Endowment Fund [EF], contributions of 120 US Dollars can be made for 'Paul William Alexander Fellowship' [PWAFF] and 1000 US Dollars for 'Honour Roll Membership' [HRM] The contributing persons name and an appropriate message will be written in the 'Golden Book' which is permanently displayed in the IHQ. An attractive Golden Pin and a Certificate for displaying will also be issued to the contributor. In addition a Crystal Glass Iceberg Memento is also given to the Honor Roll Member. The interest received from this fund is used to further the cause of Y's Dom, the principal remains untouched.
Roll Back Malaria [RBM] is another important project of Y' Men International to eradicate Malaria and make the world free from that disease. As we all know malaria is a parasitic disease transmitted by the bite of infected mosquitoes. Once the first symptoms appear, malaria can kill the person very rapidly. 300-500 million cases of malaria are detected every year and cause up to 3 million deaths, mostly children under the age of 5 years. Roll Back Malaria's strategy includes distribution of insecticide-treated mosquito nets to prevent mosquitoes from infecting people. Hence members of Y's Men International united together world widely in this mission with a slogan- make a better world for all mankind.
